NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given to all parties who wish to participate in the Public Hearing for the proposed **52MW Chico Run of River Hydropower Project** on **October 12, 2017** at the **Willaim Hall, M Hotel, Brgy. Appas, Tabuk City, Kalinga**, onsite registration is at 8:00am and the Public Hearing proper will promptly start at 9:00am.

The public hearing aims to achieve efficient exchange of information and views between and among the project proponent, the EMB-DENR, relevant agencies, LGUs and other stakeholders on the environmental impacts of the proposed project currently applying for an Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC).

Karayan Hydropower, Inc. is proposing to develop the **52MW Chico Run of River Hydropower Project** to contribute to the Department of Energy (DOE) projected 4,100 MW additional generating capacity needed by 2018 to meet the demand for electricity in the Philippines and participate in the development of alternative energy and renewable fuels and lessen the country's dependency on oil and coal.

Components	Main components are: Weir, Powerhouse, Reservoir, Gated spillway, tailrace and a 6 meter wide bridge to replace the current hanging bridge in the area.
