NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given to all parties who wish to participate in the Public Hearing for the proposed **BATANGAS PETROCHEMICAL COMPLEX EXPANSION PROJECT** of **JG SUMMIT HOLDINGS, INC. (JGSHI)** on 15 November 2017 (Wednesday) at the Batangas Provincial Auditorium, National Road, Brgy. Kumintang, Ibaba, Batangas City. onsite registration is at 8:00am and the Public Hearing proper will start at 9:00am.

The public hearing aims to achieve efficient exchange of information and views between and among the project proponent, the EMB-DENR, relevant agencies, LGUs and other stakeholders on the environmental impacts of the proposed project currently applying for an Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC).

JGSHI proposes to consolidate all seven (7) issued ECCs for the Petrochemical Complex and increase the capacities of existing Naphtha Cracker Plant and Polymer Plants. It involves the introduction of Bimodal Polyethylene, Butadiene Extraction and Aromatics Extraction, and the expansion of tank farm facilities, and possibly new/additional/upgrade of pier and other utilities facilities.
