NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given to all parties who wish to participate in the Public Hearing for the proposed **MANDAUE RECLAMATION PROJECT** on 1 August 2017 at the Mandaue City Cultural and Sports Complex, Ouano Ave. Mandaue City (onsite registration is at 8:00am and the Public Hearing proper will promptly start at 9:00am).

The public hearing aims to achieve efficient exchange of information and views between and among the project proponent, the EMB-DENR, relevant agencies, LGUs and other stakeholders on the environmental impacts of the proposed project currently applying for an Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC).

The proposed reclamation project aims to address the need for new land for housing, commercial, industrial, institutional and other related activities imposed by the increasing urbanization in the province of Cebu especially in metropolitan areas. Following briefly describes the project.

Brief Description	:	131 Hectares Reclamation Project in foreshore areas and parts of the sea over the Mactan Strait shore that will be implemented in four (4) phases over an estimated period of six (6) years
Proposed Location	:	Barangays Paknaan and Umapad, Mandaue Cebu
Proponent	:	GlobalCity Mandaue Corporation and City Government of Mandaue (Joint Venture) * The LGU of Mandaue as part of its patrimonial interest as a local government unit signed a memorandum of agreement (MOA) with the Philippine Reclamation Authority last December 2, 2008 to undertake reclamation within its territory

All interested parties who wish to participate and be prioritized in the open forum during the Public Hearing may pre-register in person with the EMB at EMB Bldg., DENR Compound, Visayas Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City and submit a position paper to the EMB Central Office or EMB Region VII office with address at Greenplains Subdivision, Banilad, Mandaue City, 6014, Cebu on or before July 27, 2017.
