



1. Introduction

- ¹ Lumino Energy Plantations, Inc. (LEPI), the “Proponent”, is a member of the Solariant Capital Group, and was established last 2nd of July 2019 for the purpose of developing and operating sustainable tree plantations that comply with local regulations and uplift local communities. Solariant Capital, LLC, along with its subsidiaries, has been actively developing and investing in renewable energy power plant projects and related energy fuel since its inception in 2012. Solariant Capital, LLC is a renewable energy development and investment company headquartered in Pasadena, California, and with offices in the United States, Japan (Tokyo), South Korea (Seoul), and Southeast Asia (Manila).
- ² The Lumino Monkayo Tree Plantation Project is a joint project between LEPI and the Unified Tribal Council of Elders/Leaders Association Incorporated (UTCELAI) through a Memorandum of Agreement. The current Ancestral Domains Sustainable Development and Protection Plan (ADSDPP) of the UTCELAI will be updated to consider the Project with the guidance and support of the NCIP. LEPI's operations will be in accordance with the approved ADSDPP. In addition, the Integrated Forest Management Agreement (IFMA) application for the Monkayo Project Area is ongoing with the DENR Region 11.
- ³ The council is the awardee of the ancestral domain CADT R11-MON-0703-0007 with a land area of 30,522.92 hectares. The project will plant *Acacia mangium* to produce approximately 300 cubic meters (cu.m.) per hectare, and the target projected annual yield is 1,107,492 cu.m. of wood materials in the 11,074.92 hectares plantable.
- ⁴ The trees will be planted in areas identified as production forests by both LEPI and UTCELAI. Areas such as sacred grounds, secondary forests, buffer areas, and others considered as protection zones will be avoided excluded, protected, and forest regenerated. The cycle or rotation period is three years to be managed by LEPI in coordination with UTCELAI.
- ⁵ The contract was executed between LEPI and UTCELAI to meet the following specific objectives:

 - To plant biomass species in the whole production areas of CADT R11-MON-0703-0007.
 - To provide revenue shares to the indigenous people on the gross income and provide them Community Development Fund (CDF) annually for twenty-four (24) years as stipulated in the MOA.
 - To help the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) in abating illegal logging within the CADT R11-MON-0703-0007.
 - To help the National Commission on Indigenous Peoples (NCIP) in making the lives of the IPs within CADT R11-MON-0703-0007 uplifted through LEPI social interventions and business portfolio.
 - To provide mechanisms for business opportunities for the IPs not only with LEPI but also with other institutions.
 - To make this as a social contract between LEPI as world class biomass raw materials provider and UTCELAI as an IP group of whose lives will be changed for the better, by engaging with direct foreign investments.
- ⁶ LEPI is applying for an ECC for the proposed project with the technical assistance of Green Development Sustainable Solutions, Inc. (GSSI). As part of the substantive review process, a public hearing must be conducted to provide an additional opportunity for the public to review the study results and submit written or verbal comments.
- ⁷ This Public Hearing Report is being submitted to the DENR-EMB for approval in compliance with the Guidelines on Public Participation under the Philippine Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) System - DENR Administrative Order No. 2017-15.

¹⁵ The opening program commenced with an invocation by Datu Salvador S. Ocbong, followed by the singing of the national anthem. Engr. George Silvederio from DENR-EMB Central Office acknowledged the participants' presence, and Hon. Don Martesio, the Mayor's representative, delivered the opening remarks.

¹⁶ Subsequently, an orientation on the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) was facilitated by Engr. Aerlyzah Anne Reyes from EMB-Central Office. She outlined the EIA process, while Ms. Miralou A. Blanco explained the session's flow, purpose, and house rules for the open forum.

¹⁷ The session then transitioned to the presentation of the Proposed Lumino Monkayo Tree Plantation Project by a representative from LEPI. Following this, GSSI presented the Results of the EIA, covering baseline studies for Land, Air, Water, and People modules, and addressing potential community impacts. The corresponding Social Development Plan, Indigenous People Plan, and Impacts Management Plan were also discussed.

¹⁸ The open forum ensued under the guidance of Ms. Marilou A. Blanco, allowing for participant engagement and discussions.

4. Issues and Suggestions Raised during the Open Forum

4.1. Highlights

¹⁹ The public has raised significant concerns during the open forum discussion including apprehensions about the exclusion of DENR National Greening Program (NGP) projects from LEPI's project development, the potential impacts of the plantation on indigenous species and wildlife habitats, queries about LEPI's operations in other areas, and environmental concerns during site clearing in preparation for the project. Additionally, there were requests for transparency regarding the cost of trees for the Wood Pellet Plant, and assurances about the protection of endangered and vulnerable species. Stakeholders emphasized the importance of safeguarding ancestral lands and protected areas while expressing support for the project, contingent on environmental and indigenous considerations. Overall, the majority of those who participate in the open forum has expressed their eagerness for the progress of the project. In addition, the responses highlighted ongoing efforts to address these concerns and collaborate with stakeholders for a comprehensive and sustainable project implementation.

²⁰ Summarized below are the key points of discussion:

- Martije Ropel, a representative from DENR-PENRO DDO, has raised concerns about the exclusion of DENR's NGP projects within LEPI's project site development, the indigenous species and wildlife habitat within the project site. Hannah Balassu, the LEPI GIS Officer, confirmed the exclusion of NGP projects in accordance with their tree inventory based on the MOA negotiations with UTCELAJ and NCIP.

- Datu Edgardo Aglit, the Tribal Chieftain of Brgy. Naboc, hoped for the expedited ECC process, expressing eagerness for the overdue project. Marilou Blanco, the EMB 11 representative and Hearing Officer, explained the ECC review process the need to address concerns, if any, before the release of ECC.
 - Carlos Duron, the Municipal IPMR and IPO Chairman of UTCELAI, inquired about the report completion as the IPs are eager to start the project. Emilyn Bengil-Precioso, the LEPI Project Manager, asked for the IPs support to expedite the project's commencement.
 - Mike Labrador, an IP Consultant and Secretary-General of UTCELAI, asked about expected issues and concerns that require immediate actions that might prevent future complications. Marilou Blanco explained that there's one for SDP as the next forum, but that is outside the EIA process.
 - Roberto Daymiel, an IP member from Awao, inquired about LEPI's operation in other locations. Emilyn Bengil-Precioso explained the non-operation and ongoing permit compliance for LEPI's other projects.
 - Josephine S. Conserva, PENRO DDO expressed concerns about the different species inhabiting the project site, and environmental effects of the project. For. Jan Paolo Pollisco, the Greendev representative, discussed the impact on biodiversity as well as the corresponding mitigative measures and biodiversity conservation plan.
 - Datu Rudy Dagpilan, the Brgy. IPMR/UTCELAI Council, reminded DENR about the resolution regarding their NGP projects within ancestral domains. For. Elma A. Cortez, the DENR-CENRO representative, acknowledged receiving the resolution.
 - Bobby Moralo, an IP Member from Awao, inquired about the cost of trees for the Wood Pellet Plant. Emilyn Bengil-Precioso responded that they were in discussions with FPIC and should have internal discussions for the pricing concerns.
 - Elvie Avena, an IP member from the Upper Ulip and a Brgy. Council raised concerns about cutting endangered and vulnerable species during site clearing. Sarah Muhsen, LEPI's Project Manager, assured them about their compliance with DENR regulations regarding protected species.
 - Datu Salvador S. Ocbong, the UTCELAI Vice-Chairman/IPMR of Brgy. Casoon, and Hon. Jose Cabag, the Brgy. Captain of Baylo, emphasized protecting the ancestral lands and protected areas and trees. LEPI has noted the concerns.
 - Nadin Lungan, an IP member from Brgy. Upper Ulip, and Aurelliano Cerna, the UTCELAI Ancestral Domain Manager, has both requested the participants for support for the project.
- ²¹ The issues and concerns raised by the public during the open forum were summarized by the EMB-CO Representative Engr. George Silvederio while Engr. Aerlyzah Anne Reyes closed the public hearing with the discussion of the next steps and the way forward after the public hearing, particularly the review by the EIA Review Committee that will follow and the channels where the participants can monitor the progress of the ECC application of the project.



Monkayo Project Location









- Air quality in AQ1 can be considered as slightly polluted while air in Sitio Liwanag indicates good air quality.
- Fugitive particulates will come from the use of access and logging roads during operations.
- Elevated suspended particulate concentrations are expected during extended periods of no rain. These may be limited to a few days because the area is under a Type IV climate.



We shall not jeopardize our ancestral lands either. Every action is preceded by a consultation. We will not permit the cutting of those Narra trees either. We will support the plantation, but what matters most is that those protected areas stay intact, which will eventually affect us as well. We assure everyone to keep our ancestral domain safe. We expect this as a big project here in Monkayo. A while ago we talked about its effect. I have asked this also during the FPIC Process. We worry about the chemicals that might affect our farm.		This was noted. There will be mitigating measures.

Nadin Lungan, <i>IP Member Brgy. Upper Ulip</i>	<p>It's been years now but the company is not yet operational. We understand such a situation because we witness every activity that the foresters do. The company is very compliant. We should support the company until it will commence its operation. On behalf of the IP members present, I am requesting everyone to support this initiative. There are areas here in Monkayo that are still vacant. As such, community members also will acquire employment that will somehow sustain their day-to-day sustenance.</p>		
Aurelliano Cerna, <i>UTCEL Ancestral Domain Manager</i>	<p>The project was not yet implemented due to some documents that need to be complied with. We will wait and support the proponent in every action they do to fast-track its process. This will be the last public hearing. I request everyone to support the company.</p>
