**DENR ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

**SUBJECT: Implementation of EIS-Information System, CNC Automated Processing System, GIS Maps of Environmentally Critical Areas**

Consistent with the Department's thrust towards increased efficiency and transparency in the Philippine Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) System, the following tools shall be fully utilized and implemented.

1. Online EIS Information System

- All Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) and Certificate of Non-Coverage (CNC) applications shall, upon submission, be immediately encoded into the online EIS Information System, which shall then assign these applications their official ECC CNC reference codes.
- ECC & CNC issuances and other major activities undertaken for pending applications shall be immediately posted on/reported to the online Information System, which shall then share this information with the Central Office and the public through the official websites.

2. CNC Automated Processing System. All CNC applications shall be processed using prescribed Automated Processing System.

3. GIS Maps of Environmentally Critical Areas. The determination of whether a Non-Environmentally Critical Project (Non-ECP) is not located in an Environmentally-Critical Area (ECA) and thus, merits a CNC shall be the responsibility of DENR/EMB and done using the Geographical Information System (GIS) maps prepared by the Central Office, to be validated and confirmed by respective regional offices.

This Order shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
